b. Ratification of Winter By-Election Results - Chief Electoral Officer, Deondrae Thompson

- I. The Results of the Winter By-Election
 - The following questions were asked to LEC students via an online poll:
 - Do you support Dyllan Scott as your 2023 Minister of Off-Campus Affairs?
 - ➤ 114 total votes: 99 yes, 4 no, and 11 abstained.
 - ➤ The majority of votes are yes; Dyllan Scott is voted in by LEC students as the 2023 Minister of Off-Campus Affairs.
 - Do you support Ishita Gurav as your 2023 Minister of Health Issues?
 - ➤ 113 total votes: 81 yes, 10 no, and 22 absatined.
 - ➤ The majority of votes are yes; Ishita Gurav is voted in by LEC students as the 2023 Minister of Health Issues.
 - Do you support Aditi Midha as your 2023 Junior Senator?
 - > 111 total votes: 94 yes, 6 no, and 11 abstained.
 - ➤ The majority of votes are yes; Aditi Midha is voted in by LEC students as the 2023 Junior Senator.
 - Do you support Alisha Gopinath as your 2023 Minister of Sustainability?
 - ➤ 108 total votes: 87 yes, 8 no, and 13 abstained.
 - ➤ The majority of votes are yes; Alisha Gopinath is voted in by LEC as the 2023 Minister of Sustainability.

d. Student Supports - Ajamu Attard

- I. TCSA Student Support Presentation
 - Land Acknowledgement was spoken.
 - Ajamu was briefly homeless when he was 16 and stayed at the YES shelter in Peterborough. He was able to get the support he needed. This inspired him to provide support to those students who need it.
 - Service package: Udemy (Real-World Job Skills), Calm (Meditation and Mindfulness), ProWritingAid (Grammarly but with more features), Nimbus (Online tutoring), Aaptiv (Pocket personal trainer).
 - With a levy fee, students can have access to all of these services.
 - The levy fee would be about \$17 a semester.
 - Question from Lily: Regarding pricing, is the pricing of these supports/services stable, or will it increase dramatically in the future? Answer: Yes the prices seem constant over the next five years. As well, each student will have the option to opt out of the levy fee.
 - Question from Cabinet: Do we need to bring anything up to TCSA? Answer: Yes it would be nice to bring this up to the TCSA as a petition.
 - Deondrae would like to have more discussions with Ajamu regarding the services and supports.

e. Junior Common Room Couches - Noah Edwards

- I. Removal and Purchase of JCR Couches
 - ²/₃ of the couches in the JCR are damaged and in poor condition. Christine has passed over some concerns from Facilities to get them removed.
 - 2 couches should be removed, 1 of the couches could stay or be removed. He is proposing to authorize the removal of them.

- Christine is suggesting a mid-century modern design for the new couches to stay with the style of LEC.
- Christine's suggested couches are blue, but an issue is that they're both velvet and might be harder to clean.
- Christine also suggested a site called Article which had more durable couches. They have polyester fabric which would be easier to clean. It would cost about \$4,500 for both of the couches that Noah is suggesting.
- We could make a decision today, or wait until after reading week to make a decision on buying it.
- Noah then proceeded to show the different types of couches on Article for possible ideas.
- Lily asked if we considered couch/cushion protectors. It was concluded that that is a good idea.
- Sarah suggests non-removable pillows so no one steals them. Noah suggests possibly sewing them to the couch if that's the case.
- Jenah expresses concern that if the legs are skinny they might break easier.
- Noah suggests that people look for possible ideas to bring to the next meeting.
- Alisha asks what the budget is for the couches. Deondrae and Noah answer about \$5,000 for two couches.
- Noah is going to be making a post on Microsoft Teams.

- a. Minister Of Communications and Publicity......Jenah Williams
 - I. Advertising for Events

b. East vs West Updates......Maria Buckle

- I. Updates and Discussion
 - Meeting with Jess, the Otonabee College Principal, and the President of College Affairs at Traill, Krista.
 - They are hoping to work together to make this happen.
 - We have new posters and ideas for locations of posters. Ideas for Instagram accounts to reach out too.
 - Plans for an East Bank and West Bank drink and pizza.
 - Tickets are going to be \$10 and will be sold at cabinet offices and online through e-transfer.
 - Still working on insurance and contract.
 - Price is higher than in previous years because everything is going to be open at the arena (not just renting out the ice).
 - No raffle or thundersticks.
 - Projected date is Mar. 16th, there are going to be 3 buses on each side shuttling people to the arena. Victoria had suggested an event at the Social after.
 - Maria has an East vs West Responsibilities sheet.
 - They hope to start advertising the event after reading week. As well, they're going to try and find an East vs West Constitution.
 - Dante's Question: If we're advertising after reading week, are we going to have to advertise both our Formal and East vs West at the same time since they're about a week apart? Maria's Answer: We're going to try and advertise them the same amount. Other cabinets are going to help out.
 - Players have not been reached out to yet.

- Kari says that they have the contact information for the Social for a possible East vs West after-party. Noah suggests that they should suggest it as an event to the Social so that they can organize it if they'd like to. It would just coincidentally be right after the East vs West Bank. Dante suggests that they should make it open to the public, which it would be if the Social runs it.

- I. Ticket Sales
 - Update: Ticket prices for the formal are now \$10 both in-person and through e-transfer.
 - Not everyone on the cabinet has purchased a ticket yet. Please buy tickets asap so that they have numbers for food at the formal.
- II. Budgets and Updates from The Social
 - They found news that food is going up \$7 a plate because of inflation. Because of this, food prices are increasing which means they need more money.
 - New budget for total expenses is about \$14,620.
 - Deondrae asks if they'd like to ask for \$3,000 instead of their original asking amount.
 - Discussion about salad ensues. The conclusion is that garden salad is more accommodating than caesar salad. There is a discussion that it would probably be good to take out the caesar salad before the garden salad.
 - In terms of the menu: Dessert, vegetarian lasagna, salad, sirloin steak, etc.
 - Free mocktails! The only thing you will have to pay for at formal is alcoholic beverages.
 - The menu is not 100% finalized, once they get all of the dietary restrictions finalized the menu will be finalized.

- Alisha suggests that we also have a photo booth. Dante says we'll have photographers. Alisha also suggests that we should use these unique features/activities in advertising to stand out.
