What is a study permit?

- A study permit is a document issued by Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada which **defines your status in Canada as a temporary resident and student**.
- **Has specific conditions and requirements** such responsibility to keep study permit valid, actively pursue studies (remain enrolled in each mandatory term) and make reasonable progress toward completion of studies. It also may have working conditions [R186(f) and (v)].
- It is **not an entry document** but required to study within Canada.
- **Cannot enter Canada with simply a study permit**; also require an entry document such as a Temporary Resident Visa (TRV), (eTA) electronic Travel Authorization, or passport depending on country of citizenship.

Who needs to extend their study permit?

Typically a study permit is issued the regular length of your studies or the length of your passport, whichever comes first.

If your study permit will expire prior to your degree completion, you should apply to extend it.



If required, renew your passport and then extend your study permit.

When to extend your study permit

- Apply to extend your study permit at least 30 days before it expires, though we recommend starting the process 3-4 months prior to expiry.
- If you apply to extend before your study permit expires, you can continue to study/work under the same conditions as your current study permit until we make a decision. This is called "maintained status". Maintained status only applies as long as you remain in Canada. Do not leave Canada until you obtain your new study permit!

Put a reminder in your calendar 4 months prior to expiry to extend your study permit!

Did not apply to extend prior to expiry



- If you do not extend your study permit prior to expiry, you lose your student status. You must stop studying and working immediately.
- You have 90 days to apply to restore your status. You must remain in Canada while your status is being restored and cannot study or work.
- If you do not apply to restore your status within 90 days, you must leave Canada.
- Contact International Advising if your study permit has expired and you have not applied to extend. We can support you with a restoration application and discuss your next steps.
- Visit the IRCC website to learn more about restoring your status as a student.

What do I need to apply?



- An [IRCC Secure Account](#) - the entire application is completed online through account
- A [valid passport](#) - note: study permit will not be issued past passport expiry
- A [valid study permit](#) at the time of application
- A [Letter of Enrollment](#)
 - Graduate > myTrent > Academics > Verification of Enrollment
 - Undergraduate/Certificate > myTrent > Register > International Verification of Enrollment
- [Proof of funds](#) - tuition for one academic year + \$10,000 for the applicant plus an additional \$4,000 for first dependent family member, and \$3,000 for each additional dependent family member.
- A [digital photo](#) - taken within the last 6 months

Applicants may require:

- [Biometrics](#) if have not submitted within last 10 years
- A [medical exam](#) in some circumstances

How do I extend my study permit?

Apply [online through IRCC Secure Account](#).
Simply type "IRCC Secure Account" in your search engine to locate the login page.

Sign in to your IRCC secure account

Your account lets you start an application, submit and pay for your application, get messages related to your application, check the status of your application and update your information.



Depending on your application type, you may not have heard from us or seen changes in your application status.

- If you've had a [medical exam](#) or given [biometrics](#), they won't show in your account **until we process them**.
- We currently have a backlog of medical exams to process, but when we do process them, **you'll see them in your account**.

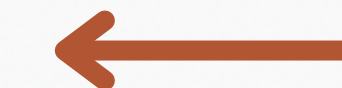

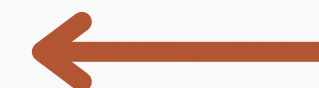

A medical exam is needed for foreign nationals who:

- want to stay in Canada for more than 6 months and have lived in one or more [designated countries or territories](#) for more than six months in the past year or;
- intend to work in one of the following jobs:
 - health sciences worker
 - clinical laboratory worker
 - patient attendant in nursing or geriatric homes
 - medical student admitted to Canada to attend university
 - medical elective and physician on short term assignment
 - teacher of primary or secondary schools or other teachers of small children
 - domestics worker, someone who gives in-home care to children, the elderly and the disabled
 - day nursery worker

If you fit into one of these categories, you need to get a medical exam.

Will you be getting a medical exam before submitting your application? Sending medical results, if required, as part of your application package will speed up the processing of your application.

For a medical exam, you must see a physician on [Canada's list of Panel Physicians](#) **(required)** ?

Submitting your application

On the screen, you will be asked to upload the documents for your application. Please do not use your browser's navigation buttons, 'Back' and 'Forward', as they will not work properly within this application.

You must be logged into your own account to submit an application. You cannot use another person's account.

✓ Step 1: Use your account

If you select the exit button, your information will be saved and you will return to your account home page.

You can continue your application at any time by logging into your account and selecting the e-Application link under the In-Progress section.

Please note that you have 60 days to submit your online application. The number of days remaining to submit your application appears in your account home page. If your application is not submitted within 60 days, it will automatically be deleted.

✓ Step 3: Upload your documents

Here are some guidelines for your documents:

- Your form(s) and document(s) must be in an electronic format.
- You do not need to sign your application form by hand if you submit your application form online. You will be asked to provide a digital signature once you are ready to transmit your documents.
- One file will be allowed per document type. For example, if you are asked to provide multiple pages of your passport, you must scan and save all pages as one file.
- You will be required to upload every requested form and document. You will not be able to proceed to the next

✓ Step 4: Pay your fees

After you have electronically signed your application, you will be asked to pay your fees. Your fees must be made with a credit card. You will be required to provide credit card information to complete your payment. We accept Visa, MasterCard, American Express and certain prepaid credit cards.

Once you have paid your fee, you will receive a payment confirmation page. When your payment has completed processing you will receive a message with your confirmation number and a link to your payment receipt. You should print this page for your records.

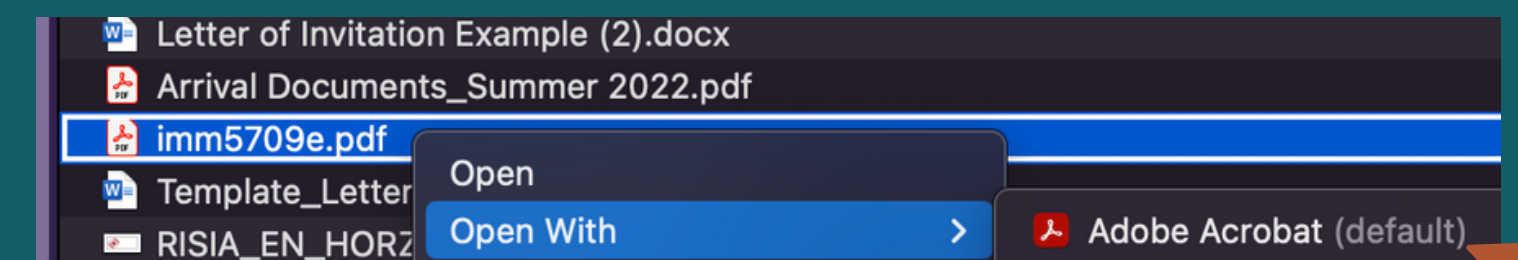
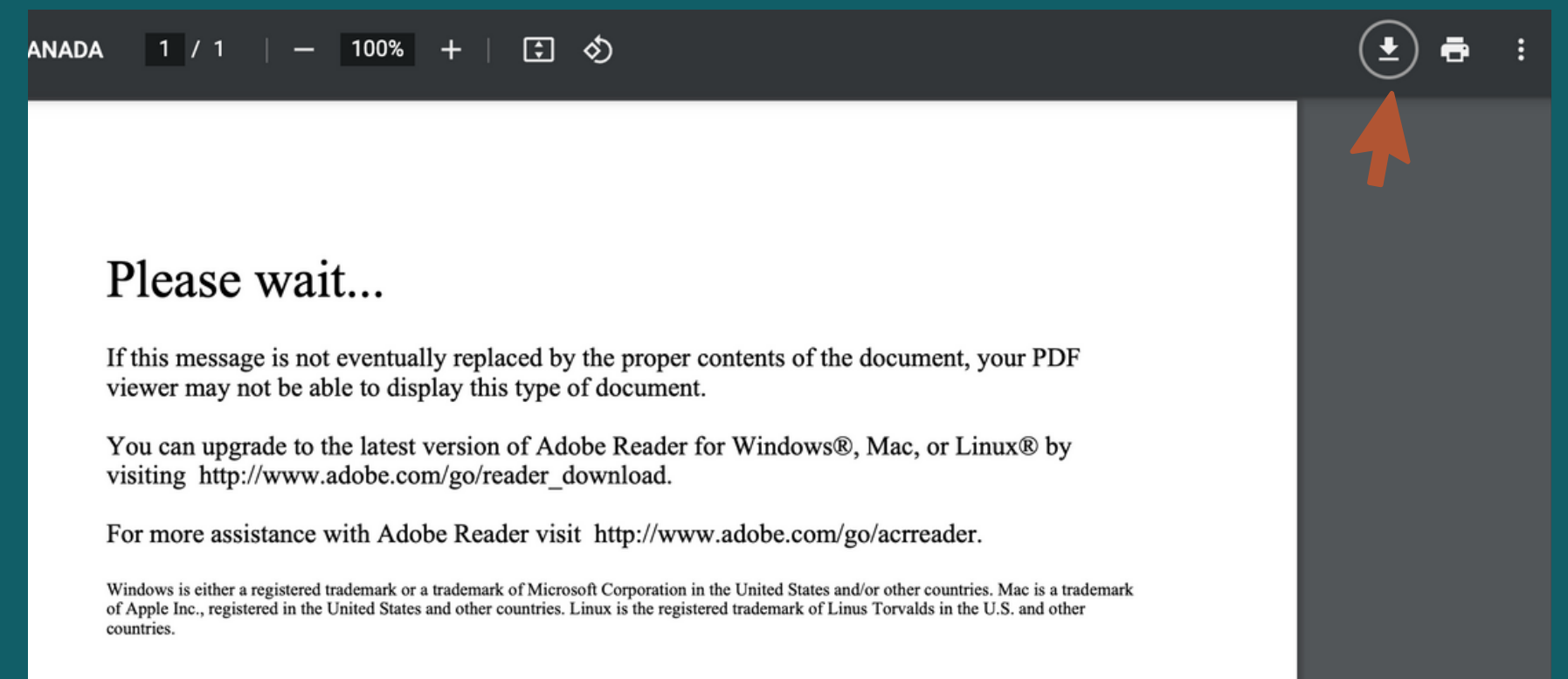

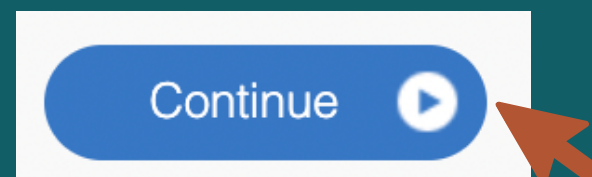
