- Commenting upon students' work as required.

Duties related to the position, shall be determined by the person(s) who has (have) principal responsibility for the course.

- Familiarity with Indigenous Knowledges
- Ability to use Voicethread (VT) and work comfortably within Blackboard in a fully online, asynchronous course environment
- Ability to communicate and work collaboratively with the instructor, workshop leaders and GTA's in the course with respect to communication, assignment submission and marking
- Familiarity and comfort with participating in Voicethread seminar discussions as well as grading and providing feedback on student presentations, seminar comments, annotated bibliographies, and student research papers.
