Nomination Deadlines:

Semester 1 (September) – Monday 3rd April 2023

Semester 2 (January) – Monday 2nd October 2023

Application Deadlines: *students to complete online application and submit all supporting documents (ie: passport, English qualification, recent academic transcript and (if required) portfolio.)*

Semester 1 (September) – Friday 14 April 2023

Semester 2 (January) – Friday 20 October 2023
